United States Preventive Task Force (USPTF) Recommendations



Abdominal Aorta Aneurysm (AAA) Screening

CMS Criteria:

- No prior AAA screening and either
- Men & women 65 75 with a family history of AAA

or

Men age 65 – 75 who have smoked at least 100 cigarettes in their lifetime

ICD-10:

- Z13.6 screening for cardiovascular disorders and either
- The most appropriate code for tobacco usage: Z87.891, F17.210, F17.211, F17.213, F17.218 and F17.219

or

 Z84.89 for family history of other specified conditions (must be documented in the EHR)

CPT:

 76706 ULTRASOUND, ABDOMINAL AORTA, REAL TIME WITH IMAGE DOCUMENTATION, SCREENING STUDY FOR ABDOMINAL AORTIC ANEURYSM (AAA)

Low Dose CT for Lung Cancer Screening

CMS Criteria

- Age 50 77 years
- Asymptomatic (no signs or symptoms of lung cancer)
- Tobacco smoking history of at least 20 pack-years
- Current smoker or one who has quit smoking within the last 15 years

ICD-10

- Z87.891 for former smokers (personal history of nicotine dependence) or
- F Codes for current smokers: F17.21, F17.210, F17.211, F17.213, F17.218, F17.219

CPT:

- CPT G0296: one-time counseling visit to for shared decision making reguarding risk, benefits side effects annual LDCT scan. In person or telehealth counseling.
 - *Must occur before the first LDCT
 - *Must be documented in the EHR
 - *Add -25 modifier to the E&M if completed during an office visit
- CPT 71271: CT, thorax, low dose for cancer screening without contrast material.

Screening for Osteoporosis

CMS Criteria:

- Women 65 and older
- Postmenopausal women with risk factors*
- Men 70 and older with risk factors*

ICD-10

- M85.89- Other specified disorders of bone density and structure, multiple sites.
- N95. 9 Menopausal and perimenopausal disorder, unspecified
- Other menopause codes

<u>CPT</u>

77080 Dual-energy X-ray absorptiometry (DXA), bone density study, 1 or more sites
